

5. Secondary services

Please use the following services if you desire additional in-booth work on the lines to be installed in your booth in accordance with the processes described thus far. (These services can be provided by other businesses that you designate; however, you will need to deal with these businesses should problems arise.)

a. Secondary services

i. What are secondary services?

These services provided everything from technical consultation on the network environment in your booth to rental, construction, and maintenance of communications equipment. Wiring and construction within your booth, rental of hubs, setting of devices, and other services are offered at Tokyo Big Sight if you wish to connect several PCs to a single line for Internet use, connect to a LAN, etc. They include everything up to connection of your own PC to the Internet. **Our service is limited to installation and connection to our wired router in the booth. For further connection, users need to bring a device with a LAN port and LAN cable to connect to the router.**

Please set up your wireless environment by yourself.

ii. Connecting the customer's PC to high-speed optical communications service

b. Items to bear in mind when using secondary services

i. Scope of services provided

Includes everything from the line installed in the booth to the terminal (PC, etc.)

Services cover everything from installation of LAN cable within your booth, rental of hubs, and set up that includes connection to the Internet to explanations on use and maintenance during the event (maintenance technicians will respond quickly in the event of a problem).

Our service covers from the ONU to our wired router installation and connection in your booth. Please set up your wireless environment by yourself.

ii. We will check the specifications of the PC and peripheral devices you wish to bring to the event after receiving your Application Form.

iii. Service is limited to computers with a Japanese or English OS .

Windows within the product support lifecycle and Mac with a version of up to 2 previous generations are accepted for our service.

iv. Additional fees may be charged for changes made to construction details.
